Readings: Isaiah 66:10-14, Galatians 6:14-18, Luke 10:1-12, 17-20

Reflection

"What Sunday is it today?" "Oh, it's one of those Sundays in Ordinary time but don't ask me which one - it's Ordinary time and they're all the same"

Which is sort of true but they're not – the very idea of Ordinary Time sounds so "Ho Hum" after all the great Feasts we've had – Holy Week, Easter, Ascension Day, Pentecost, Holy Trinity, Corpus Christi – and just like that they've all gone and everything is so dull.

Except that it's NOT dull - it's a bit like having been on a great series of chefprepared meals and then going home to casserole or chops or a vegan meal: it's a return to our basics of life

And so it is with the Sundays of the year – ordinary time is getting back to the basics of your faith life - you've watched Christ rise, you've watched him go back to His Father; you heard all about Pentecost – the fire was sent down – and, with a bit of luck the fire has entered your belly and you're full of the light of Christ; well, OK, let's not get too carried away with all this fire and light and stuff – all very areat for those who are dedicated and stuff – but I'm not really dedicated – just because I come to church on Sunday you can't really see me standing on the street corner, can you? Me, standing on a street corner, Ha!

But you really do have that fire in you even if you think you don't - the fire got into your whole being so that you walk the whole earth with respect and care and so that you may always walk away from what is harmful. And the fire is in your thoughts making them good and just – and in your ears – so that you may hear the flow of water and of all Creation and be protected from gossip. But, say you, I pretty much do that all the time (not always, I mean be fair, me - I'm not one of those overly holy people - I'm just me). Yep, just like the seventytwo others mentioned in this morning's Gospel – they were sent out just as you and I were sent out and their names are written in heaven – as are yours.

Which means that the fire of Pentecost really HAS got into you and you're living in God's house every day of your life.

CONGRATULATIONS - you're one of God's elite and all that happened is that you're living your life as God intended you to do!

SO – it's really NOT just another Sunday in ordinary time – it's a special YOU Sunday Tony de Joux
