Advent Communal Celebration of Reconciliation and Anointing.

The Spirit provides the grace that allows us to include and transform together in a Communal way through forgiveness within our celebration of **Reconciliation and Anointing**

Remember, when we speak of Advent or preparing for Christmas, we're not just talking about waiting for the little baby Jesus to be born. That already happened 2,000 years ago. In fact, we're welcoming the Universal Christ, the Christ that is forever being born in the human soul and into history.

And believe me, we do have to make room, because right now there is no room in the inn for such a mystery. We are present here tonight to make that room in ourselves.



So what is Rite III?

The defining characteristic of Rite III is when a priest is able to absolve a large group of people who have expressed sorrow for sin without hearing an individual confession.

- It includes a communal prayer of confession and forgiveness.
- Followed by individual anointing with the sacred oil of healing.
- Then there is a general absolution by the priest, leading us into our communal act of sorrow as a sign of our new beginning within each of our lives

Let's continue to pray for one another over this time. Amen. Fr Pete

To help us prepare this Advent there is a prayer and shared reflection time.


When: The following three Sundays - 3, 10, 17 December
