"Divided tongues, as of fire, appeared among them, and a tongue rested on each of them.

All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them the gift of speech." Acts 2:3-4



I'd have loved to have been a lizard on the wall at Pentecost – just to watch the effect of the coming of the Holy Spirit on all those dispirited individuals cowering in the upstairs room. What an amazing sight it must have been!

Look around any group of people that you know well – let's say 10 of your family, friends or acquaintances. Call each one to your mind's eye...one at a time - think about each one of them...their good points, their not-so-good points, their lovable traits, their facial features, their predictable behaviours, expressions...the list goes on...

Each of them is a different, unique, individual person. While none of them is everybody's cup of tea, fortunately, each of them, including ourselves - is God's cup of tea! Each is needed by the whole universe.

And each of them – each of us – is becoming what God wants us to be. And that's what holiness is! God doesn't ask us to become someone else (that's impossible). Holiness comes in as many different sizes and shapes as there are unique individuals. Holiness is the perfection of who God created each of us to be. And that's reassuring. If we just let God work through who we are, the stuff of which God has made us...we will be made holy and perfect.
