#### Reflection

There is much going on.

On the International scene: war in Ukraine, threats over Taiwan, torrential rain in Pakistan, heat waves in the UK and USA.

Nationally: rising inflation, Covid constancy, historical abuse in our state and faith institutions, unrelenting pressure on our health, education and welfare systems.

Personally: a priest friend who committed his life to service slowly nearing the end and letting go.

Sometimes it is hard to makes sense of what surrounds us and how to live through it.

So today's gospel provided an opportunity to pray and to hear what life is telling me.....again.

Then I realised that the parish Confirmation programme I have been involved in, helped make sense of todays Gospel.

Over the past months we explained to our children that through **Baptism** they joined the Catholic family of 1.17 billion.

They were given a job to do in our world and values to guide them. Then their parents said "I do" for them when asked do you believe/accept your child's God given mission?

At Confirmation the children say "I do," "I will", for themselves.

They accept their personal mission to serve, love, forgive, respect, grow and hope and to be fuelled by the power of the Spirit.


Nathaniel Centre director Dr John Kleinsman has been acting Chief Executive in the meantime.
