Twenty Third Week Ordinary Time 10th September 2023, Year A Readings:: Ezekiel 33:7-9, Romans 13:8-10, Matthew 18:15-20

When two or three...

I always loved numbers and I like things precise. So, it is no wonder that, as a teenager, I was struck by a comment I heard about today's Gospel "For where two or three meet in my name, I shall be there with them" (Mt 18:20). If you think that today there are 200 of us in church, that's not true. There are 201!.. because Jesus promised to be with us.

Today He is teaching us a very particular prayer: "If two of you on earth agree to ask anything at all, it will be granted to you by my Father in heaven." (v.19)

"If two of you..." Another number: two! Jesus doesn't say: two saints, two priests, two adults, but simply two: a father and a son, a couple... What's important is the plurality. In order to obtain an answer from heaven, this prayer requires more people: a community.

"If two of you... agree". He wants us united, in agreement of hearts. Why?

Certainly, what we ask together is less spoiled by self-interest, we are more inclined to feel the needs of other, but the point is: if we are united, Jesus is among us, so He is praying with us and the Father will listen to Him.

And what can we ask? "Anything", there is no limit.

Today we might want to pray for families, that they may fulfil their vocation to holiness in their daily lives, experiencing God's infinite mercy and always finding new ways to grow in love; we pray for the lonely, people struggling

with mental health, the sick; for peace in our hearts and in the world; for the care of our 'common home'; above all, we pray for the courage to always strive for mutual love and be worthy of His presence among us.
