John the Baptist

In 2006 I was on a New Zealand delegation to the UN. I spent a weekend in Montreal before going to New York. It happened to be the feast day of St John the Baptist – patron saint of Montreal. And those people know how to celebrate their patron saint! Motor racing, dancing in the street – fantastic fun.

One of the things that the early Christian community had to deal with was the question of John the Baptist. Jesus's cousin, he lived the life of a prophet. He gathered disciples, Andrew was one of them, and he called people to repentance. His was a repentance expressed through immersion, what we call baptism. He was persecuted, imprisoned and executed. He had the look of being the messiah. Yet, looking back through the lense of the resurrection, with the benefit of hindsight and the gift of the Holy Spirit, the Christian community knew he was not the messiah.

They knew that Jesus was the Messiah. And they used Jewish scripture, in this case from Isaiah to explain how John the Baptist fits in.


John the Baptist points the way to Jesus. That's what all the Prophets and all
