Third Week of Advent, 11th December 2022 Year A Readings: Isaiah 35:1-6,10, James 5:7-10, Matthew 11:2-11

Gaudate Sunday

"With Jesus, there is always the possibility of beginning again. It's never too late. Be courageous. He is near to us and this is the time of conversion. Everyone might think: 'I have this situation inside, this problem that I am ashamed of'. But Jesus is next to you... And we are annoying, but he never gets tired! Let us listen to John the Baptist's appeal to return to God. And let us not let this Advent go by like days on the calendar because this is a moment of grace, a grace for us too, here and now!" (Pope Francis, Angelus 4 December 2022)

And today the liturgy invites us to joy! The Advent wreath typically has four candles — three purple and one rose-coloured. The rose candle is lit on the Third Sunday of Advent which is also called *Gaudate Sunday*. Rose is a "brightening" of the ordinary violet and symbolizes the joyful anticipation of the season culminating in the birth of Jesus at Christmas.

It is not a superficial or purely emotional cheerfulness, but rather, it entails a more authentic joy, the taste of which we are called to rediscover. "Courage! Do not be afraid." — the Prophet says — "Look, your God is coming... to save you" (Is 35:4). And everything is transformed: the desert blooms, comfort and joy permeate hearts (cf. vv. 5-6). The taste of true joy! It is a joy that touches our innermost being, as we await Jesus, who has come to bring salvation to the world. God has entered history in order to share our existence and to free us from all forms of interior and exterior slavery.



Christmas is near: decorations, lights, gifts... These outward signs invite us to welcome the Lord who always comes and knocks at our door, knocks at our heart, wants to be near us. He invites us to recognize Him in each person who pass us by, and to share our joy and hope with others. Let's be ready for Christmas, preparing our hearts to welcome Jesus.

St Francis of Assisi Parish – Transitional Church

We have confirmed dates for the closing of each of our churches in January and February 2023 and the opening of the transitional St Francis of Assisi Ohariu Parish Church on 19th February.

The planning for the transformation of St Peter and Paul's Church to a Parish Church which looks and feels different is progressing. As we confirm details of the transitional church, we will provide you with some details so it's not a complete surprise.

There are some important principles that apply to this change:

- 1. Create a spiritual space which is different to what we have known
- 2. Retain things from our three churches in our transitional church
- 3. Experiment with different layouts as we plan for a new church
- 4. Be flexible
- 5. Be open to new ideas
- 6. Be welcoming

In order to experiment with different layouts, we will be removing the fixed pews from Ss Peter and Paul. The transitional church will have a mixture of pews and individual seats which will be movable. We will seek feedback from parishioners and move the furniture to try different layouts from what we have known in our existing churches.

We are considering improving the audio-visual equipment in the church including the hearing loop.

If you use hearing aids, we would be interested to know if you have any issues with the hearing loop. Please contact the Parish Office or someone from the Leadership Team.

Last week a small group of parishioners set up a house for an incoming refugee family. With the gifts from parishioners of both practical and beautiful linen and kitchen items, and with assistance from Challenge 2000, we were able to set up house for 11 people with personalised bedding, a full kitchen and well-stocked pantry. The family were very quick to pass on, via Red Cross, their heartfelt thanks and gratitude for this generosity, as they start their new life in New Zealand.





Our stocks are now depleted. We used up all our supply of single sheets, blankets, duvets, duvet covers

and towels. We also need to acquire more kitchen items: family-style/robust dinner sets, pots and pans with lids including stock pot, sets of mugs/cups, cooking utensils, cutlery, bowls, etc. Plus electrical items such as an electric jug, toaster, electric beater/blender, vacuum cleaner, iron, rice cooker.



If you have any of these items which you would like to donate, I'd be pleased to collect them, ready for the next family set-up. The parish has now equipped 26 family homes (since 2015) which is a tribute to the small team - thank you volunteers - and the generous gifts from parishioners.
