# <u>Reflection</u>

Last year's Palm Sunday Newsletter Fr Pete quoted Richard Rohr -

"....It seems that we Christians have been worshipping Jesus' journey instead of doing his journey. The worshipping feels very religious and safe: the latter just feels human and ordinary. We are not human beings on a journey toward Spirit, we are already spiritual beings on a journey towards becoming human, which for some reason seems harder precisely because it is so ordinary....."

My mother used to often use the phrase "just offer it up".

Maybe we can spend the last two weeks before Easter Sunday doing the ordinary small human things that we need to do because this is what we can "offer up" every day instead of waiting to make a great sacrifice that will somehow make up for all the times we could have just "offered up " a little.

"Each one must give as he has decided in his heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver." (2 Corinthians 9:7).

Did you know, we at St Francis of Assisi Ohariu Parish, have the option of "Automatic Payments" that helps you contribute online and not having to find notes/change every Sunday.

You can do this directly via an auto-debit with your bank or drop us an email at <u>office@stfrancisohariu.nz</u> and we can email you the set up instructions in creating an automatic payment (weekly/monthly) according to your convenience & budget.

No more envelopes, no more cash!! Moreover, we keep the records & you are entitled to a tax deduction certificate every year (March end) that gets you **33.33%** back from the IRD at the year end for all your donations to the church.

(Example: A \$20 automatic payment per week equates to \$1040 per year. IRD gives you \$346.62 straight credit back into your bank account. but the church gets the full \$1040 to use for operating costs)

Also, if you are you not a member of our parish yet but drop in every other week and are contributing cash in the collection basket!! You too have the option to simply convert it to an envelope with your details, to ensure we keep the records and provide you with a donation certificate at the end of the financial year to allow you to claim back **33.33%** of all your support during the year.

#### Planned Giving

We have so many heart-warming stories of planned giving to share from amongst our parish, that has benefitted so many causes and people's lives.

There are many ways to give through planned giving, including bequests, charitable gift annuities, and charitable remainder trusts. Each option helps you achieve your charitable goals.

Our team is here to help you understand your options and to answer any questions you may have.
