Ascension of the Lord 29th May 2022 Year C Readings: Acts 1:1-11, Ephesians 1:17-23, Luke 24:46-53

Jesus says to us in the Ascension Scriptures this weekend:

"Why do you stand looking up toward heaven?

You are **witnesses** and **see**, I am sending upon you what my Father promised; so stay here in the city **until** you have been clothed with power from on high".

Jesus lived and died to show us the whole deal of who we are and what and how we are called to be. On the day of the Ascension his disciples who he had lived with and who finally understood his life and love, knew he was off on the next stage of his life.

And they were okay with this - even joyous- because they finally knew, they finally "saw". They understood his life and why he had come. They understood how they needed to be and what they had to do on the next stage of their lives. They got it. At last they understood.

It's the same for us today. Its no use us looking up to heaven for Jesus. He is here amongst us. He is in us. He is with us. Jesus is in everything and everyone. He is calling us to be him, to be his witnesses, every day and in every way. We are not Jesus observers, Jesus explainers, Jesus historians, Jesus controllers or hander outers.

We are his living, loving witnesses, filled with the Spirit, clothed with power and love to be his words- gospels, dreams and actions in our parish, communities,

homes and country today. What a gift, a privilege and a vote of confidence Jesus has given us. We're here that's why he could go away.

This week let's sit for a few minutes. Picture him and hear what he is saying now.

Breathe his Spirit in for a while and pray:
Jesus help us to see you and help us to be you so that with smiles on our faces we can carry you to the places where you are most needed. Amen.
