One afternoon as I was tidying the house, I found this little quote hidden in one of the shelves:

Love is always anxious. Not because we have doubts about the person we love, but because we feel responsible for enriching one another with new discoveries, inspirations, changes, which at times we don't even realise. This anxiety is, in itself, a source of happiness.

- Francis X. Nguyen Van Thuan.

This quote struck me so much I've kept it in my room ever since.

One could sense the urgency of wanting the best for the other, the passion of helping the other to reach their fullest potential.... Though it requires constant effort, it requires sacrifice but it's so worth it because as Cardinal Van Thuan implies: we find joy in seeing the others fulfilled. Hospitality will be led by Pat and Judith. All very welcome.


Columban Calendar 2024
