Reflection

Saints Abdon and Sennen, are recognized by the Catholic Church and Eastern Orthodox Church as Christian Martyrs, with a feast day on 30 July.

A Persian nobleman who suffered martyrdom with his companion, St. Sennen. St Abdon, and St. Sennen were venerated as early as the third century. The martyrs were exposed to persecutions in the reign of Emperor Decius and were carried in chains to Rome around 250 A.D. There, they were put in an arena with wild animals but remained unharmed as the animals refused to slay them. Gladiators were sent in to kill them as a last resort.

Abdon and Sennen are patron saints of Calasparra, in Murcia, Spain. The feasts days celebrated in their honour in this Spanish town date back to the 16th century. (Catholic Voice Foundation USA – Catholic Online).

Synod

The Synod will be in two parts.

Section A has "the aim of focusing with greater clarity on the fundamental characteristics of a synodal Church, starting from the experience of walking together lived by the People of God in these two years and gathered in the documents produced during the first phase".

"The Assembly is asked to conduct its work in an integral manner considering the experience of the People of God as a whole in all its complexity". (Remember the original commitment: nothing will be lost).

"The Assembly will then proceed to address the three priority issues that emerged from the consultation phase". These are,

- "1. How can we be more fully a sign and instrument of union with God and with the unity of all humanity?
- 2. Co-responsibility of Mission: how can we better share gifts and tasks in the service of the Gospel?
- 3. Participation, governance and authority: what processes, structures and institutions are needed in a missionary synodal Church?".

"Five worksheets correspond to each of the three priorities".

To help with getting to the new venue we put on a bus for our Grandparents and other whānau, separate from the children. We had a great uptake of this, and we will provide it again next year.




We were delighted to have several of our Grandparents' take part in the liturgy with their Grandchildren by taking up offertory, reading a prayer or as Eucharistic Ministers.


