Second Week of Advent 5th December 2021 Year C Readings: Baruch 5:1-9, Philippians 1:3-6,8-11, Luke 3:1-6

Repentance and Joy

The call in today's Gospel is to repent. It is a call to turn away from sin and face Jesus on the cross and accept His forgiveness. It is a call to have our hearts and minds open to the Holy Spirit dwelling within us and leading and guiding us.

One outcome of sincere repentance is peace and joy.

The prophet Baruch writes of the Israelites rejoicing at the way God has remembered them and brought them back to Himself and his Holy City. The psalmist tells of the songs of joy sung by those the Lord brought back to Zion.

Paul writing to the Philippians tells of his joy at the way the Philippians are now following the way of Jesus, adding that he is confident Jesus will continue to empower their work until the very end.

Joy, often a deep down quiet joy, always follows when we are in the right relationship with God and with others. This is a beautiful and precious outcome of repentance, it is to be cherished.

Covid Vaccine Passes required at all Masses and Liturgies from Friday 3 December

On Friday 3 December Wellington moved to Orange under the Covid Protection framework. **Everyone aged over 12 and 3 months must show a Covid MyVaccine pass when you come to a Mass or Liturgy.**

<u>Orange:</u> You will need to show your Covid Vaccine pass when you arrive at the church. You won't need to book but you will need to wear a mask and scan in or register in writing.

Should we move to <u>Red</u> you will need to show your Covid Vaccine pass when you arrive. Masses will be limited to 100 people. You will need to book and must wear a mask.

Everyone over 12 and 3 months will need a pass. You can get a pass at https://covid19.govt.nz/covid-19-vaccines/covid-19-vaccination-certificates/my-vaccine-pass/ If you don't have a computer, phone: 0800 222 478 and have your NHI number ready.
