- Nick and Ed volunteered to be involved in the group

- Look at from first arrival to involvement in first ministry
- Review yellow welcome forms, welcome pack?

- Talk with various parishioners and stakeholders currently involved in hospitality
- Include feedback of a newly arrived person
- James & Joanne to be involved in this group
- There was a suggestion we could set up and run hospitality as a PPC to connect with parishioners occasionally
